

## You’re in Someone’s Head

I’m taking a little time out from writing this week’s sermon on the temptations of Christ to write this brief article. I know I’ll have nothing new to say on the topic, but I’m trying to be as original as possible. As I read and reread the passages involved (Matthew 4, Luke 4 and Mark 1) I keep hearing my father’s sermons. His three favorite lessons to preach were Philemon, Paul on Mars Hill (Acts 17) and the Temptations of Christ.

That’s not a bad thing. Harry Graham was an insightful Bible teacher. I’ve heard several other preachers preach about Satan’s encounter with the Son of God in the wilderness, but no one quite brought Dad’s perspective to the study. I can’t forget some of his main points: the answer to temptation is “it is written,” the Devil knows the Bible and misquotes it freely, and the Devil is powerful and was in control of the whole world.

We leave behind many important lessons. How to tie your shoes. How to drive a nail. How to bake a cake or bar-b-que a chicken. How to tie a proper fishing knot. How to throw a curve ball. Far more important than those lessons are the spiritual words shared.

What legacy are you leaving behind? What words will ring in your children’s and your grandchildren’s ears? Will they remember that you shared biblical truths with them?

I’ll never forget the way Mom complemented one of my first gospel sermons. She said, “You have pretty feet” (Romans 10:15). That’s the kind of verbal legacy I want to leave, too.
