The Camper's Promise

Studying God's word always brings blessings. Three things struck me while studying Ezekiel 34 this week. One was a very familiar phrase from a gospel song. Another was a warning. The third was a statement that reinforced one of my favorite hobbies.

Verse 26 must have been well known to Major Daniel Webster Whittle when he wrote the lyrics to one of his most famous hymns. "There shall be showers of blessing" was God's promise to the exiles in Babylon. Major Whittle compared the physical promise of rain when they were returned to the land to spiritual revival.

Verse 20 is a sober warning from God, "I Myself will judge between the fat and the lean sheep." The exiles were concerned about the people left behind before the fall of Jerusalem, and the remnant of the people left in Palestine afterward. Their rulers were oppressive and unjust, but God promised a time coming when He would hold the leaders accountable. It is a sobering responsibility to lead God's people. (Hebrews 13:17)

Verse 25, though, just might be a new favorite passage. It is promising that the restored land physically, and the coming church spiritually, would be a place of complete safety. While David was a shepherd, he had to worry about the lion and the bear, but in the future, God's promise is that "I will make a covenant of peace with them, and cause wild beasts to cease from the land; and they will dwell safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods." I like that "camper's promise." I like to sleep in the woods.

Study your Bible every day. His blessings are waiting for you there.
