Be a Benaiah

I'm not enjoying the snow very much right now. A day or two of forced time off can be enjoyable, but three (so far) is a bit much. The only thing worse than being stuck indoors would be going anywhere at all in all of this ice. I haven't tried to even get the mail for fear of slipping and sliding and breaking something I would really rather not break.

Watching trucks slip and slide down the freeway reminded me of Benaiah. 2 Samuel 23:20 says:

"Benaiah was the son of Jehoiada, the son of a valiant man from Kabzeel, who had done many deeds. He had killed two lion-like heroes of Moab. He also had gone down and killed a lion in the midst of a pit on a snowy day."

Benaiah didn't take a "snow day." I wouldn't kill a lion on a nice day in a pit or out. I suppose the lion would be slipping around a little, too, but that just doesn't sound safe to me. Nevertheless, Benaiah got the job done.

Do you have any lions in snowy pits? Difficult jobs that must be done? Trials that must be faced? Conversations that shouldn't be avoided? Benaiah didn't fall in by accident. He went down into that pit and faced the lion. Paul faced his, too. His conclusion was, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" (Philippians 4:13).

God can help you and me, too. Let's take on those lions.
