**Clean As You Go**

When my two sisters were in 4-H club, our mother was the cooking teacher. I was not allowed to attend their meetings, but she would teach me what she would teach before the class met. Together, we made the completed samples of whatever she would teach them how to make before the girls arrived. It was a good idea because we lived in the Colorado mountains at an elevation of over ten thousand feet above sea level. She had to be sure the recipes would not fail. She could also be sure I understood her directions. I was younger and uninformed, so I made a good test pupil. While she was teaching me to measure and follow a recipe, Mom always stressed I should clean as I cooked.

Clean as you go is a good rule for life as well as cooking. Rather than trying to make up with a spouse that has been hurt through neglect, why not clean as you go? Bring home flowers or some special treat she enjoys occasionally "just because," not just when you're in trouble. Rather than waiting and dealing with serious discipline problems later, why not spend time teaching your children God's word and praying with them? How about hugging them regularly now? Rather than trying to redeem yourself when the boss puts you on notice that your work is substandard and you are in danger of dismissal, why not work on the job as if you were working for Jesus every day? (Colossians 3:22-24)

Clean as you go. You never know when someone will drop by unexpectedly. Instead of letting your entire kitchen become a disaster area, there will just be a bowl of ingredients you can pop into the refrigerator.

Keep your life clean as you go, too. You never know when Jesus will return. (But we do know He will.)
