**Jehoiakim's Penknife**

In Jeremiah chapter 36, God told Jeremiah the prophet to write down everything that he had been told. The resulting scroll was read at a special fast day in Jerusalem. Word quickly traveled to Judah's King Jehoiakim. He had the book read to him as well. It was winter and he had a fire burning in his hearth. As the scroll was being read, Jehoiakim used a penknife to cut the portion that had just been read from the scroll and threw it into the fire. Perhaps Jehoiakim thought that he could dispose of God's word by burning the only existing copy. One can still read the prophecies of Jeremiah, because God had him write the book again with even more prophecies added.

Jehoiakim's penknife is still active. Even though the Bible plainly condemns fornication (1 Corinthians 6:9,10; Galatians 5:19), some try to cut those words from their Bible and sing along with the country song, "How can loving you be wrong when it feels so right?" The penknife must be awfully sharp to allow the relabeling of homosexuality as an "alternative lifestyle" rather than a sin (1 Corinthians 6:9; Leviticus 20:13). It has been honed to a razor's edge to make ending an unborn life into an inalienable right. Cursing, theft, wrath, lust, and scores of other pet sins are kept alive by a sharp penknife. It is best not to use one that way (Revelation 22:19).
