**Elder of the month: James Herring**



**"Congratulations on Your Independence: Say 'Hello' to My Soldiers."**

Monday evening, February 21, 2022, Vladimir Putin recognized the independence of two break-away provinces in eastern Ukraine. Then he marched "peace-keeping" troops into those provinces. Somehow, to Putin, independent seems to mean, "under my control." It seems quite like the freedom Hitler offered Austrians, Czechs, Poles, Dutch, Belgians, French, Norwegians and Russians (and many others) in the late 1930s and early 1940s.

Human spiritual independence is an illusion. While faithful Christians are made free from sin and its eternal consequences in Christ (Romans 6:18), Paul declared that I am a slave to either sin or obedience.

"Know ye not, that to whom ye present yourselves as servants unto obedience, his servants ye are whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?" (Romans 6:16)

"And being made free from sin, ye became servants of righteousness." (Romans 6:18)

As Satan's slave I may be "free in regard of righteousness" (Romans 6:20) but that freedom kills (Romans 6:21). I can claim total freedom, but that just makes me a clueless slave to sin. The choice is not absolute independence versus slavery. As Joshua exhorted Israel, "Choose you this day whom you will serve" (Joshua 24:15). My choice is to serve the Lord who died for me. Like Paul, I want to be a servant of Jesus Christ (Romans 1:1; Philippians 1:1; Titus 1:1).
