Mind Your Manners

An article entitled "Stagecoach Etiquette" appeared in the *Omaha Herald* in 1877. Among the rules cited were:

- ☞ *Spit on the leeward side of the coach.*
- ☞ *If you have anything to take in a bottle, pass it around.*
- ☞ *Don't swear, nor lop over your neighbor when sleeping.*
- ☞ *Don't point out places on the road where horrible murders have been committed.*
- ☞ *Don't grease your hair before starting or dust will stick there in sufficient quantities to make a respectable "tater" patch.*

The rules of etiquette may change from culture to culture and from situation to situation, but they must not be ignored. Peter wrote by inspiration, "Finally, be ye all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous" (1 Peter 3:8). Peter sums up this verse in the last clause, "be courteous." That means the discourteous Christian is not of one mind with his or her brethren, lacks compassion, lacks love, and is pitiless.

The reason for manners is love. It is far easier to maintain positive relationships than to repair them. Learn the wisdom of Proverbs 18:19, "*A brother offended is harder to be won than a strong city.*"

Souls are the only eternal things we interact with in this world. Treat them with care and courtesy.
