Can Do What I Can Do

Remember the old movies that ran credits briefly only at the beginning of the film and just displayed "The End" without any further credits? I seem to remember Frank Kapra's "It's A Wonderful Life" and "Mr. Smith Goes to Washington" both ended that way. These days, studios are using gimmicks to motivate audiences to stay through the credits like Matthew Brodrick asking, "Are you still here? Go home!" at the end of the credits in *Ferris Bueller's Day Off*. I suspect there is a legal reason that the director's fourth assistant in charge of snacks gets a credit. Yet, where would the movie be without those snacks?

Most plays cannot be performed without the grips – individuals who move scenery on and off stage. Athletic teams must have their trainers and student managers. For every Paul there must be a Timothy. The success of the gospel depends upon the faithfulness of not only elders and preachers, but of every member of the body.

Elisha understood that. In I Kings chapter four is recorded his most amazing miracle. Elisha raised the Shunammite woman's son from the dead. Elisha involved his servant, Gehazi, in his ministry to that family throughout that process. It was Gehazi who suggested the woman had no son and her husband was old, when Elisha wanted to reward her patronage. Gehazi summoned her to hear Elisha's promise that she would have a son within the year. Elisha made sure Gehazi was present to witness her reaction. When the boy collapsed and died, Elisha sent Gehazi ahead to hurry with his staff to place it on the boy's face. When God revived the dead child, Gehazi again summoned the mother and was there to witness her reaction.

God's work requires those "grips." Jesus turned water into wine, but servants filled the pots. Jesus healed the paralytic, but four friends had to break up the roof. Jesus fed the five thousand, but a boy donated his lunch. Don't you love the way Mark records Jesus' defense of the woman who anointed him? He said, "She hath done what she could" (Mark 14:8).

I may not do what others recognize as great things in the kingdom, but I can do what I can do.
