## Parable of the Chairs

### 1. Some folks like that easy chair

That's not what Jesus sat in. ...

vs 7: "who, in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications, with vehement cries and tears to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear, 8 though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered. 9 And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him, 10 called by God as High Priest 'according to the order of Melchizedek,' "

But too many of his followers would rather sit in that chair.

11 "of whom we have much to say, and hard to explain, since you have become dull of hearing."

### 2. Others are sitting in a broken chair.

They started out on fire for the Lord. They volunteered for many things. But something happened. It stunted their spiritual growth.

12 "For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food."

### 3. Unfortunately, some are still sitting in a highchair.

13 "For everyone who partakes only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness, for he is a babe."

Where is the mind of babies? On themselves. They cry and moan and complain when things don't go their way. You have to pamper them, and coddle them, while walking on eggshells so you don't hurt their feelings.

### 4. Thankfully, there are those sitting in the disciple's chair.

14 "But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil."

Yes, the disciple's chair is worn out with use. But it still fits, it's the most useful of all the chairs. Those sitting in these chairs can't wait to get up and do God's work...saving souls. But if you are sitting in this chair, you're still learning, whereas those sitting in the other seats think they know enough to get by.
