That was quite a Bible study. Rick knew all about how to persuade a sinner to come to Christ. Most of all, I was able to see how much Rick truly loved people and sincerely wanted everyone to share the salvation he had found in Christ. I saw the value of what I had been taught that evening.

As well as he said them, I don't remember any of the things Rick said that night. What I do remember was what the young wife said when Rick asked her to be baptized into Christ. She said, "I was wondering when you were going to ask me!"

I am thrilled to begin full time ministry again. I believe with all my heart that the school of evangelism that will open in the fall of 2022 is desperately needed.
