
Rickey and Lisa Wilson's niece's pathology report came back as positive. MRI is next to check the rest of her body. Please pray it is contained.

Let Them Surprise You

Why haven't I talked to someone about Jesus today? If I'm too busy, then I'm way too busy. If I'm too shy, I need to get over myself. If I've been burned before, welcome to the club. Not everyone even accepted Jesus during His lifetime. They crucified Him. One excuse that runs through my mind occasionally is, "She/he won't listen anyway."

Why do I think that? Just because a few have rejected my attempts, will everyone? Certainly not. I tend to be a soil inspector rather than a sower. There is plenty of rocky, "wayside" and thorny soil out there, but the only biblical way to evaluate soil is to plant the seed.

I wouldn't have expected the only faith that amazed Jesus in a positive way belonged to a Centurion. Jesus is said to have marveled at the lack of faith in Nazareth (Mark 6:6). Positively, Jesus marveled at the great faith of the Centurion of Luke 7 (7:9). If Jesus can marvel at faith in unexpected places, so can we.

I want to let people surprise me. The only way to know whether they will come to worship with me is to ask. The only way to know whether they will talk about God and His word is to ask. Let's find out.
