Don't Stop at the Door

The day that Christ was raised from the dead, two of his disciples had a foot race. Mary Magdalene ran from the empty tomb and told Peter and John that the tomb was empty. Peter and John both ran to the tomb, but John outran Peter. John stopped at the entrance to the tomb and stooped down and looked in. He saw the empty grave clothes. Peter didn't stop at the entrance, but ran into the tomb. John followed and recorded that when he, too, had been in the tomb that he saw and believed (John 20:8).

Real faith doesn't just stop at the door. The real power in Christianity is found in giving my whole life to Christ. When one counts the cost (Luke 14:26-35), takes up the cross daily and follows Christ (Luke 9:23), then the real power that can do "all things" comes (Philippians 4:13).

Too often I am tempted to pause at the door and try to examine commitment from the outside. I want a good, close look without getting involved. I didn't learn to swim or ride a bicycle that way. I had to commit myself to the process. I also learned about the peace that passes understanding by abandoning worry and giving everything to God in prayer and supplication with thanksgiving (Philippians 4:6-7). Whether, like Peter, I run right into the tomb or, like John, I follow Peter inside, faith grows on the inside. Whatever my commitment to Christ, it could probably get stronger on the inside. Inside Bible study, inside fellowship, inside worship, inside active participation, all can help faith grow. Don't stop at the door.

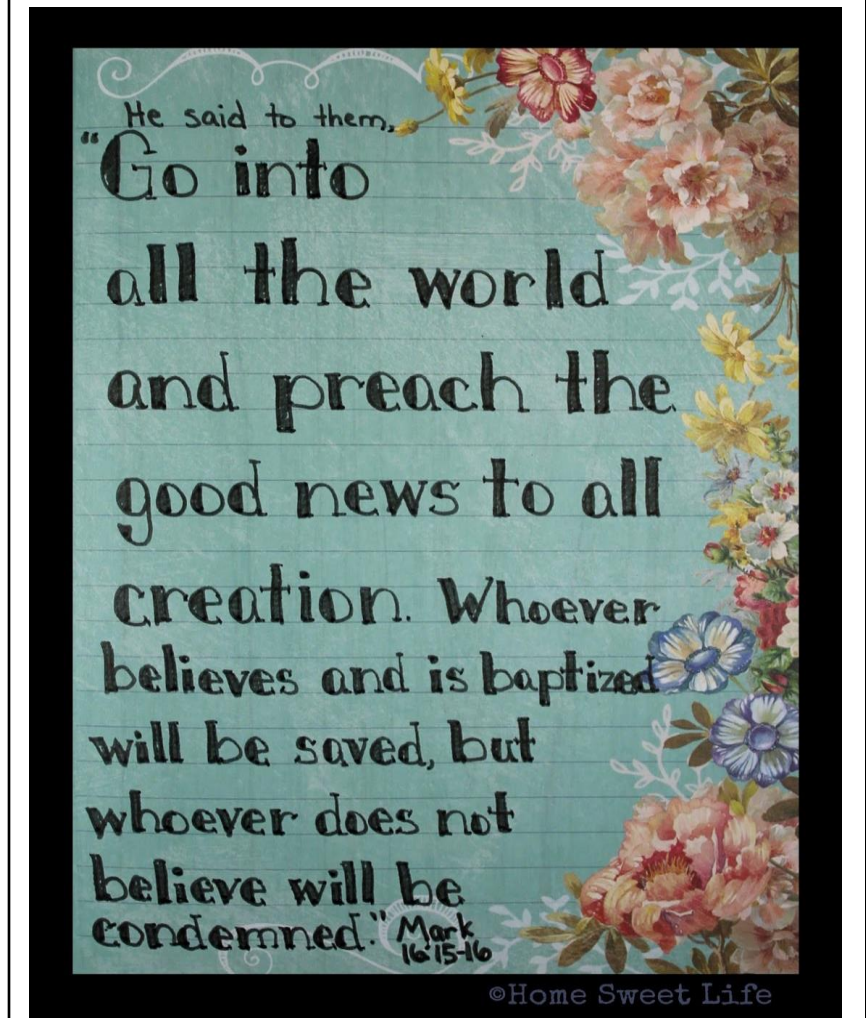
