I Am a Debtor

Romans 1:14-15

"I am a debtor both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to wise and to unwise. So, as much as is in me, I am ready to preach the gospel to you who are in Rome also."

Whom do I owe? In addition to the mortgage company, I owe everyone. I want to live as Paul commanded in Romans 13:8 and "owe no one anything except to love one another..." when it comes to money, but, like Paul, I am deeply in debt to many.

I am in debt to God, His Son, and His Spirit. Without the cross I would have no hope in this life. Paul surely was, too, but that is not his message in Romans 1:14. He knew the gospel message and owed a debt to everyone (perhaps especially, Gentiles) to share that message with them. I, too, owe everyone the gospel of Christ. I can't keep it to myself.

Have you ever played the card game "spoons?" Remember how there is one less spoon in the middle of the table? Whoever doesn't get the spoon is "out!" The smart way to play that game is to be as sneaky as possible when I get one of those spoons. I don't want to let the secret out until I'm sure I've got my spoon.

Eternity is not a game of spoons. The blood of Jesus is sufficient for the sins of the whole world (1 John 2:2; 2 Peter 3:9). Everyone must be warned of the dangers of hell. No one should miss out on the blessings of heaven.

I'm going to keep inviting everyone in my circle of influence to worship, to Connect Groups, to study God's Word and to pray. I owe them.
