Building in the Potholes

An informational meeting was held a few years ago describing the proposed resurfacing of a heavily traveled highway. A retired highway engineer was disappointed to learn that concrete would not be used. He sarcastically asked, "Will you be building the potholes in or just letting them develop naturally?"

There are many ways to build potholes in. A businessperson can predict failure through cheating customers, keeping irregular hours, failing to keep accurate accounts, or choosing a poor location. One fishing can build in potholes by having the wrong bait, failing to keep a line in the water, or fishing in the wrong place.

Christians deal with enough potholes in life without building any in. Here are a few built-in potholes to avoid...

1. Repenting of sin in general without giving up any specific evil habits or sinful practices. After all, nobody's perfect, right?
2. Be easily offended. Put the responsibility for getting along on everyone else, despite the scripture that emphasizes, "as much as lieth in you" (Roman 12:18).
3. Insist upon making your closest friendships with worldly people. Ignore the scriptural admonitions, "in honor preferring one another" (Romans 12:10) and "evil communications corrupt good manners" (1 Corinthians 15:33).
4. Skip Bible classes. That way one can know less about the Bible and be more prone to sin, after all, David said, "Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee" (Psalm 119:11).
5. Keep your commitment to Christ to a bare minimum (an oxymoron if ever there was one). After all, Jesus demands the first place in my life (Matthew 6:33) even if it means my life (Revelation 2:10).

There are enough potholes that develop in the Christian life without building them in! Lay down the solid foundation of hearing and obeying God's word (Matthew 7:24).

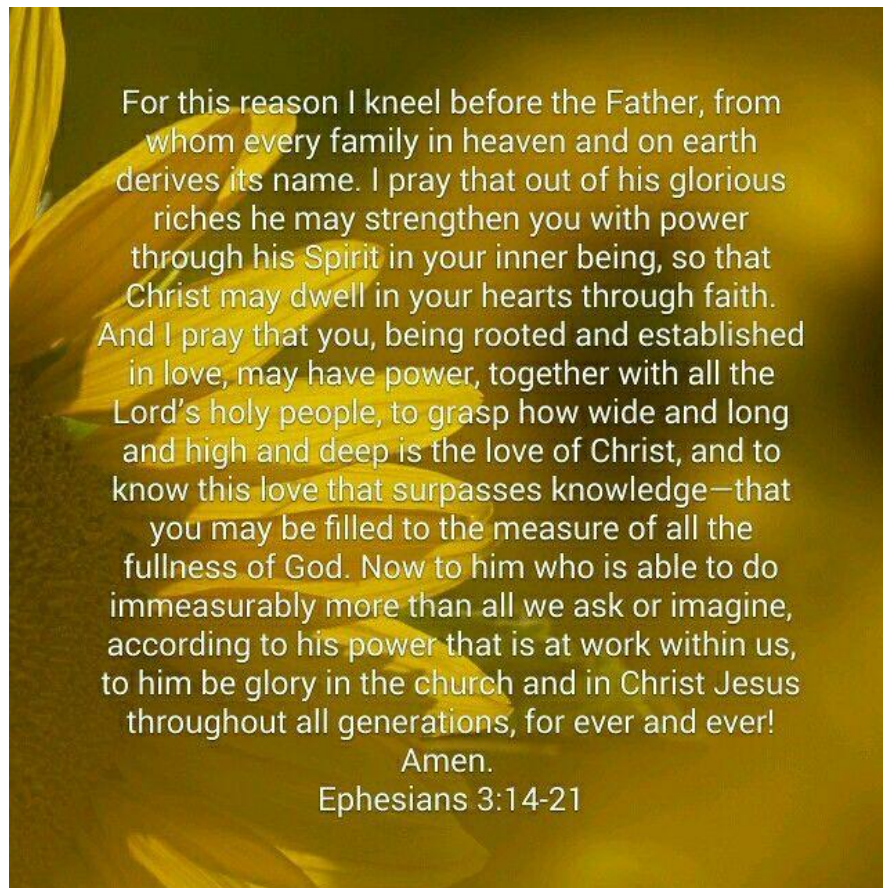
