Keep Trying

How do you think history would have treated the captain of the Titanic if he had remarked, "Why worry? After all, most ships sink eventually." Or "What difference does it make if all the lifeboats are full? After all, we've all got to go sometime." That sort of attitude is unimaginable and inexcusable. Yet it is practiced every day. Note these common but unbelievable remarks...

"The narrow way will have only a few traveling it." Quite true. There is, however, plenty of room for everyone who will obey.
