### Ask For the Old Values

*Thus, saith the LORD, stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls.*

*Jeremiah 6:16*

There has been a lot of talk about traditional values recently. Unfortunately, I fear that much of the discussion is about political expediency. When politicians find themselves in conflict with the values held by most of their constituents, they tend to be very quiet or “play to their base.” Some even play to their base in the primaries then run to the center for the general election. While I applaud a new focus on traditional values, I can’t help wondering what is meant by “traditional” values?

Instead of traditional values, what is needed are God’s values. He has spoken to man (Hebrews 1:1,2) and revealed His will. He calls the violation of His law sin (1 John 3:4) and will judge the world in righteousness (Acts 17:31). Right is right and wrong is wrong not because man has decided it in a free election, but because God said so.

Man is not a law unto himself. “O LORD, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps.” (Jeremiah 10:23). Humans determining their own values for themselves have approved everything from drunkenness to debauchery to adultery to cannibalism. If you are searching for values, look for the truly ancient ones. The tried-and-true values revealed by God in His Word.
