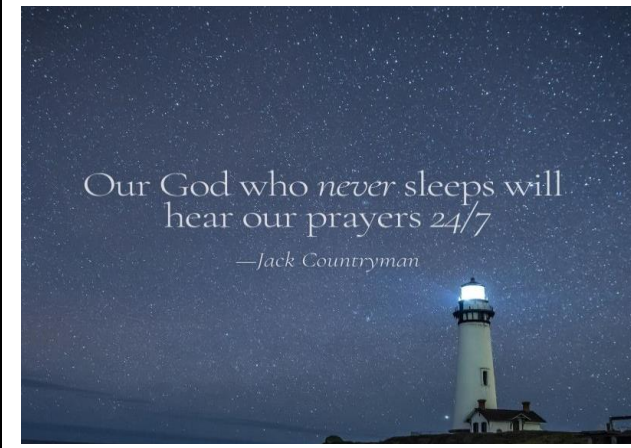

COVID Update

After much careful and prayerful consideration and review of the State, County and CDC recommendations, the elders at West Freeway Church of Christ have amended the COVID-19 protocols. Effective immediately, the wearing of masks is no longer required in the assembly or confines of the facility. You may continue to wear a mask if you choose to. In addition, the social distancing plan that was enacted (the blue tape on the pews) is no longer in effect. In respect to those who wish to continue to wear a mask and to continue to social distance, the westernmost section of seating has been set aside for you. The two center sections are available for open seating.
