How do you imagine history would have judged the captain of the Titanic if he had remarked, “Why worry? 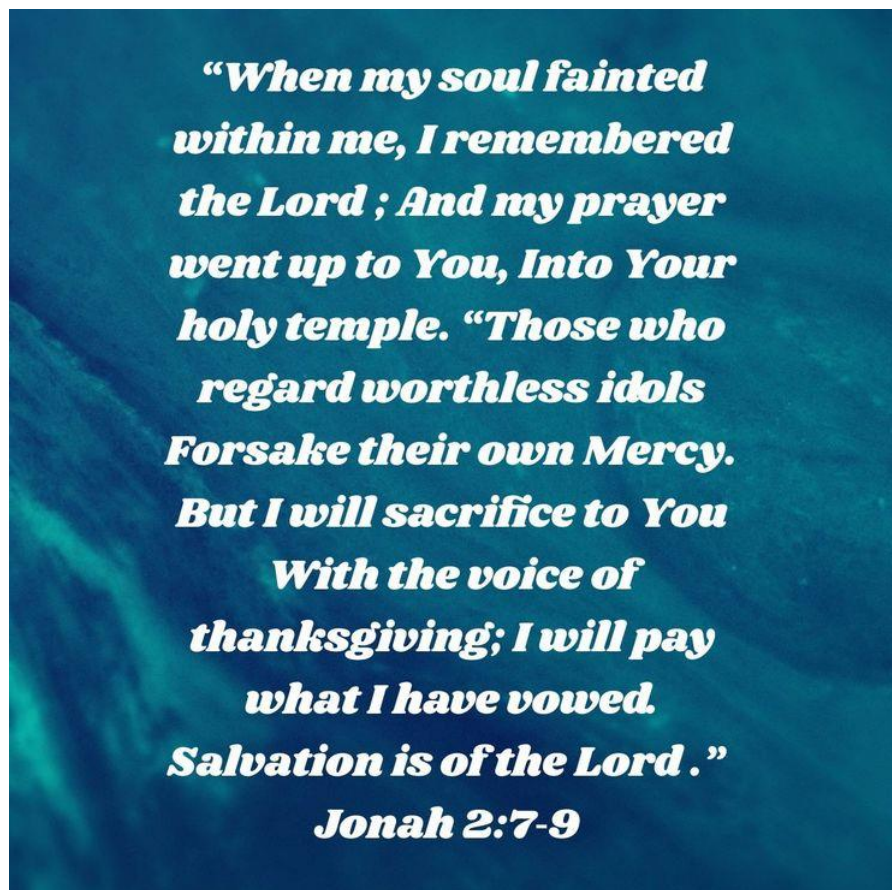
