Aspirational Responses

An article published July 4th discussed how often a person should shower. The reporter discussed a few surveys about how often people shower. According to the polls, as many as two-thirds (66%) of people report that they shower daily. "Of course," stated the reporter, "any self-reported study will include a fair number of, er, aspirational responses – so whether John or Jane Doe really are washing up on the regular is anybody's guess."

Perhaps the writer suggested that individuals tend to lie to others and even to themselves when self-reporting. Daily bathing is a relatively trivial topic (except in cramped quarters), but, I wonder, do we tend to give "aspirational responses" to more important questions?

Am I a committed Christian? (Luke 9:23)

Am I walking "in the light?" (1 John 1:7)

Do I study my Bible regularly? (2 Timothy 2:15)

Do I pray daily? (2 Thessalonians 5:17)

Do I cast all my cares on Jesus? (1 Peter 5:7)

Do I give liberally, as God has prospered me? (1 Corinthians 16:1-2)

Do I know that I have eternal life? (1 John 5:13)

Jesus warned us against aspirational responses. He spoke of those in the judgement who will argue that they had done great things for Him. They may have been saying, "Lord, Lord" but Jesus will say, "depart." (Matthew 7:21-23). Don't tell yourself, "I think so," or "I hope so." Obey God's word so you know so.

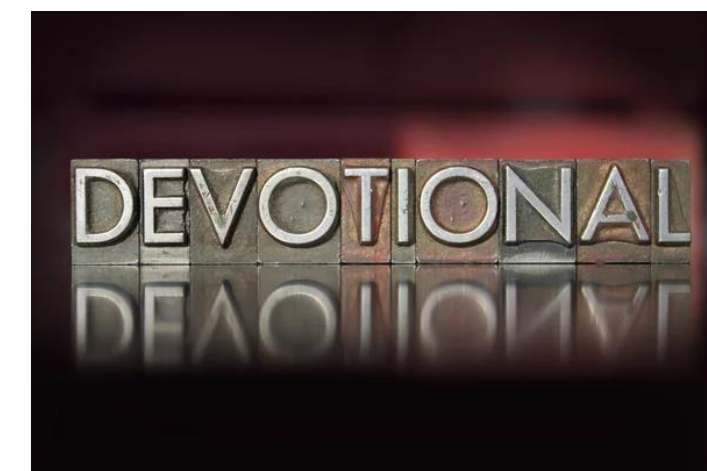
