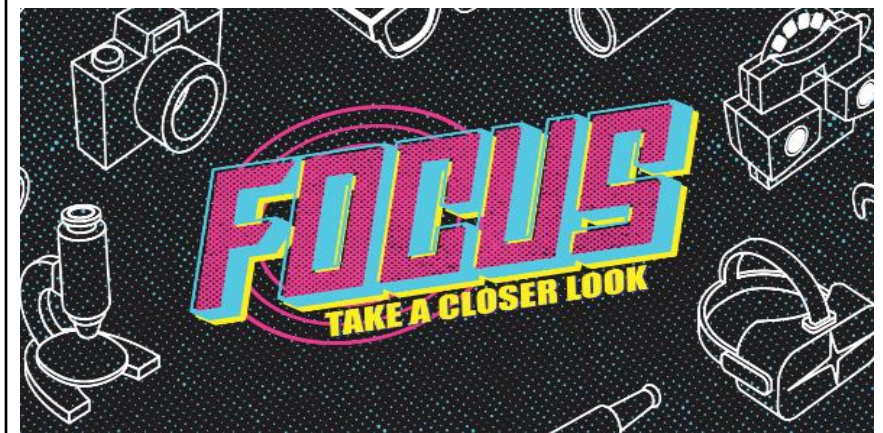
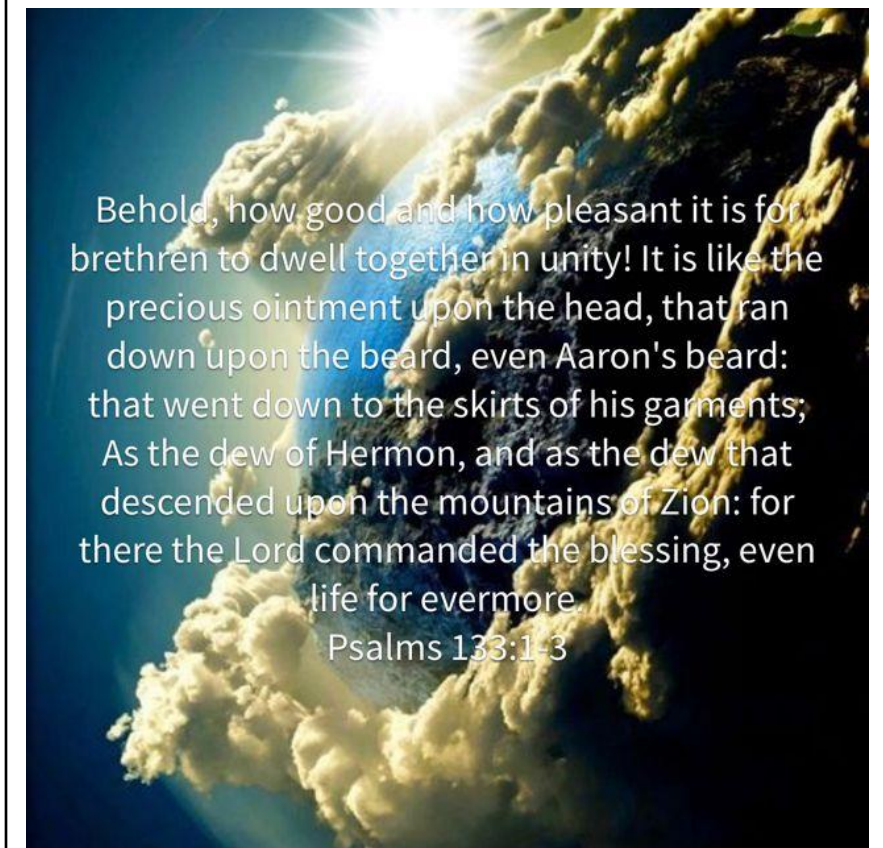

Evil Is Unimaginably Evil

It is hard to imagine just how evil sinners can become.

Tuesday, July 6, 2021, 19-year-old Danyal Hussein was found guilty of murdering sisters Bibaa Henry and Nicole Smallman in a London Park. Hussein didn’t know his victims. He had written a contract in which he promised “King Lucifuge” that he would sacrifice six women every six months until he won the Mega Millions Super Jackpot lottery. *The Independent* article published the same day ran a photo of the contract. He also promised to build a temple. He expected “to never be suspected of any crimes by the police, and also that police will never know of any crimes that I have done and that I will do.” “Danyal” was signed next to “Me:” in what looked suspiciously like blood while the line next to “King Lucifuge” was blank. Danyal had spent 162 pounds on lottery tickets and bets over the ten days after the murders. Hussein is scheduled to be sentenced by the judge, Mrs. Justice Whipple, on September 22nd.

Perhaps the apostle Paul’s description of “the lawless one” found in 2 Thessalonians chapter 2 is an example of the kind of delusions evil can bring. In verses eleven and twelve, Paul wrote,

And for this reason, God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Satan is prowling for victims (1 Peter 5:8). He is ready to help those who submit to him become more and more evil.

It doesn’t have to be that way. No sinner is beyond the grace of God. Paul, by inspiration, not only called himself the chief of sinners (1 Timothy 1:15) but also stated that he had obtained mercy (verse 13) and that saving sinners was why Jesus came into the world (verse 15). Let us get serious about winning souls. We won’t stop all evil, but God’s promise is “...*he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.*” (James 5:20). Let’s do what we can.
