Changing History

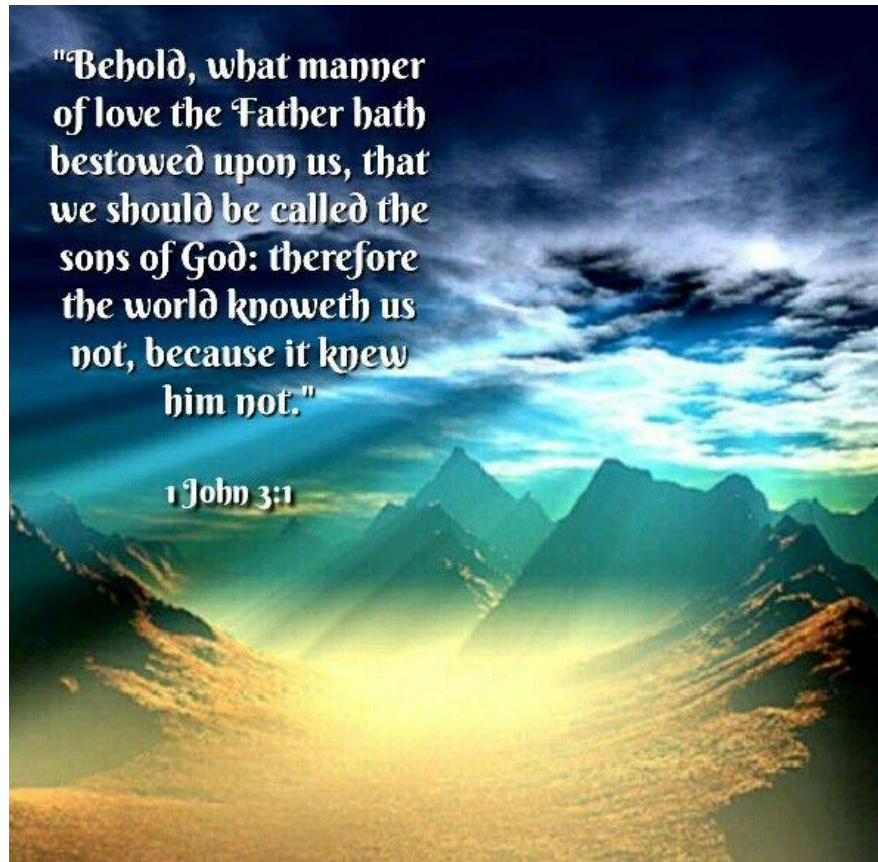
