

PSALM 1

1 Blessed is the man
who walks not in the counsel of the wicked,
nor stands in the way of sinners,
nor sits in the seat of scoffers;
2 but his delight is in the law of the LORD,
and on his law he meditates day and night.
3 He is like a tree
planted by streams of water
that yields its fruit in its season,
and its leaf does not wither.
In all that he does, he prospers.
4 The wicked are not so,
but are like chaff that the wind drives away.
5 Therefore the wicked will not stand in the
judgment,
nor sinners in the congregation of the
righteous;
6 for the LORD knows the way of the righteous,
but the way of the wicked will perish.

"Keeping Your Head on Straight"

Introduction:

1. Psalm 1 is not only a great chapter in this book, but it is one of the jewels of the Bible.
2. Today let us focus on Psalm 1:1.
3. The key word in this verse is "Blessed."
4. "Blessed" has the idea of happiness or contentment.
5. The same language is expressed when we read the Beatitudes found in Matthew chapter 5.

Discussion: So how do we keep our head on straight?

- I. Don't Listen to What the Ungodly says (v1a): "Walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly." Cf. Psalm 119:24.
- II. Don't Do What the Ungodly Does (v1b): "Nor standeth in the way of sinners." Cf. Psalm 119:68.
- III. Don't Go Where the Ungodly Goes (v1c): "Nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful." Cf. Psalm 119:53.

Conclusion:

1. Walk Not.
2. Stand Not.
3. Sit Not.
4. Follow these principles, and you will be content as a child of God.
5. Someone once said, "Success is getting what you want; happiness is wanting what you get."

Almost Persuaded

Dr. Brytney Cobia was in the news recently. The New York Post's online edition dated July 21, 2021 reproduced what appeared to be a July 18 Facebook post by the Birmingham, Alabama physician. She posted, "I'm admitting young healthy people to the hospital with very serious COVID infections. One of the last things they do before they're intubated is beg me for the vaccine. I hold their hand and tell them that I'm sorry, but it's too late." She went on to note, "It's not too late, but some day it might be."

Vaccinations are important. Salvation is more important. I could not help but think of the many souls entering eternity daily whether the virus is the cause or not. As sad as the conversations Dr. Cobia has been having are, far worse are the conversations described in scripture between Jesus and the lost.

"²¹ Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. ²² Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' ²³ And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'" Matthew 7:21-23 NKJV

Again,

"⁴¹ Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into the everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels: ⁴² for I was hungry and you gave Me no food; I was thirsty and you gave Me no drink; ⁴³ I was a stranger and you did not take Me in, naked and you did not clothe Me, sick and in prison and you did not visit Me.'" Matthew 25:41-43 NKJV

It is very sad that the infected cannot receive the vaccine that might have saved their lives had they received it in time. Far worse is to leave this life unprepared for the next. Have you been washed in the blood of the Lamb? That is the most important decision you will ever make.
