"There Is One Body"

In Ephesians chapter four, the apostle Paul begged Christians to be unified. He reminded the Christians of his day of some things of which there is only one. The text reads:

There is one body, and one spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:4-6

First of these "ones" is "one body." "Body" is a word Paul uses to refer to the church. In chapter one of this same book of Ephesians, Paul spoke of "...the church which is his body" (Ephesians 1:22, 23). In New Testament days there was only one church. They were commanded to be unified in doctrine and in practice (1 Corinthians 1:10). They were not divided into competing denominations, but they were all united in one church.

There is still one church. When one is saved, he is added to it by God (Acts 2:47). It is the body of those cleansed by Jesus' blood through baptism (Ephesians 5:26) That church will be presented at judgment as the bride of Christ (Ephesians 5:27, Revelation 19:6-9). Equally clear is that religious bodies which are not that church will be "rooted up" (Matthew 15:13).

The popular, denominational concept of the church of Christ is wrong. We cannot hack the body of Christ to pieces with each competing piece having its own distinctive doctrines and practices and still claiming to be a part of the whole. We may claim whatever we like, but the Bible still says, "there is one body." We must be a part of that one body!
