One Hope of Your Calling

*"Even as ye are called in one hope of your calling..." (Ephesians 4:4).*

When Paul penned Ephesians 4:4, Christians agreed about what hope God held out for His saints. That agreement no longer exists. Some claim the saved will become gods at the second coming of Christ. Others deny a second coming altogether. Others vary widely on the detail like the existence of a literal heaven (Revelation 21) and hell (Revelation 20:15), the destruction of the physical universe (2 Peter 3:10,11), the eternal punishment of the wicked (Revelation 14:10,11) and more. Yet, God's word revealed all these details. There were scoffers (2 Peter 3:3) and those who would deceive the faithful about Christ coming again (2 Thessalonians 2:3) even during Bible times. Yet, Paul claimed all Christians could understand God's will concerning their *one hope*.

We still can, but we must read and accept the word of God on the matter. Oh, that all who name Christ would return to the inspired basis for the unity for which He prayed! (John 17:21)

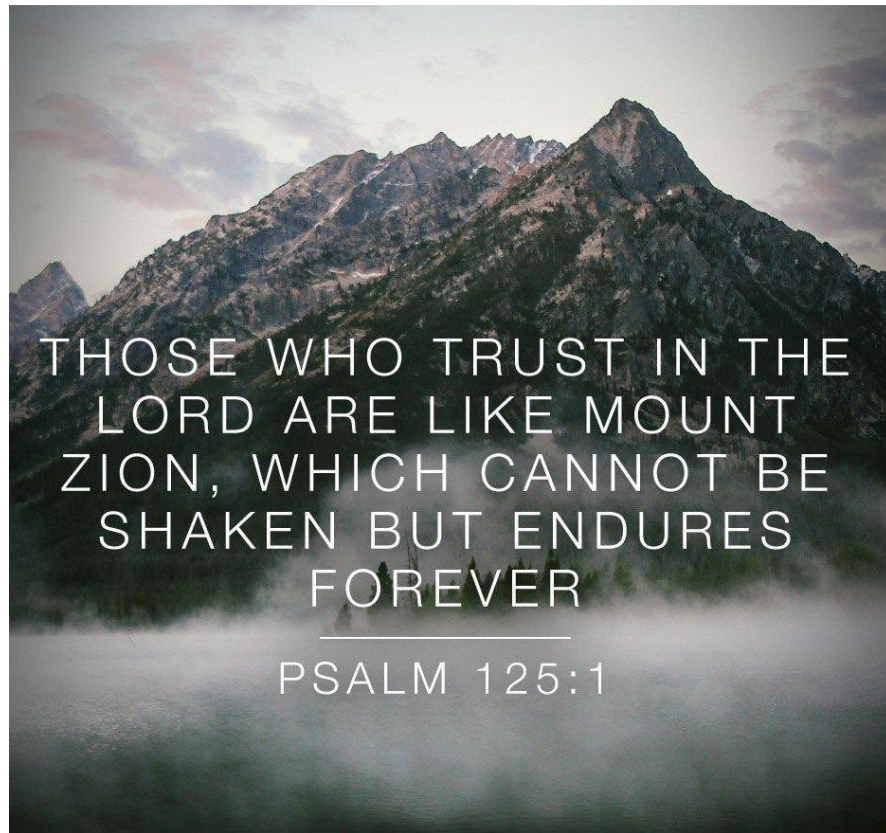

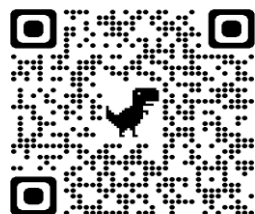
