One Lord

If Christians are ever to be united, we must acknowledge the one Lord. Ephesians 4:4-6 declared that there is only one Spirit, one Lord, and one Father. It is hard to imagine that anyone would claim to be a Christian, yet deny what the Bible says about Jesus. Yet opinions about Jesus range from those who claim He was just a good man, to those who claim He alone makes up the Godhead, and the Father and Holy Spirit are not distinct from Him in any way. Instead, note what the scriptures clearly teach about Jesus:

1. He is fully God (John 1:1,14; 10:30).
2. He is equal with the Father and the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19; 2 Corinthians 13:14).
3. He is the only sacrifice for our sins (Romans 3:25).
4. He is the only head of His church (Ephesians 1:22-23).
5. He will be glorified on the last day (Philippians 2:9-11).
6. He is the Christ (Messiah) promised by the Old Testament prophets (Luke 18:31).
7. He is personally coming to judge the world in righteousness (Acts 17:31; John 5:22,28-29; Matthew 25:31).

Accepting what the Bible says about Jesus is not optional. Jesus demanded, "If ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins" (John 8:24). My eternal salvation or damnation depends upon my acceptance of Jesus. If we ever expect to become one in Christ, we must accept His word about who He is.
