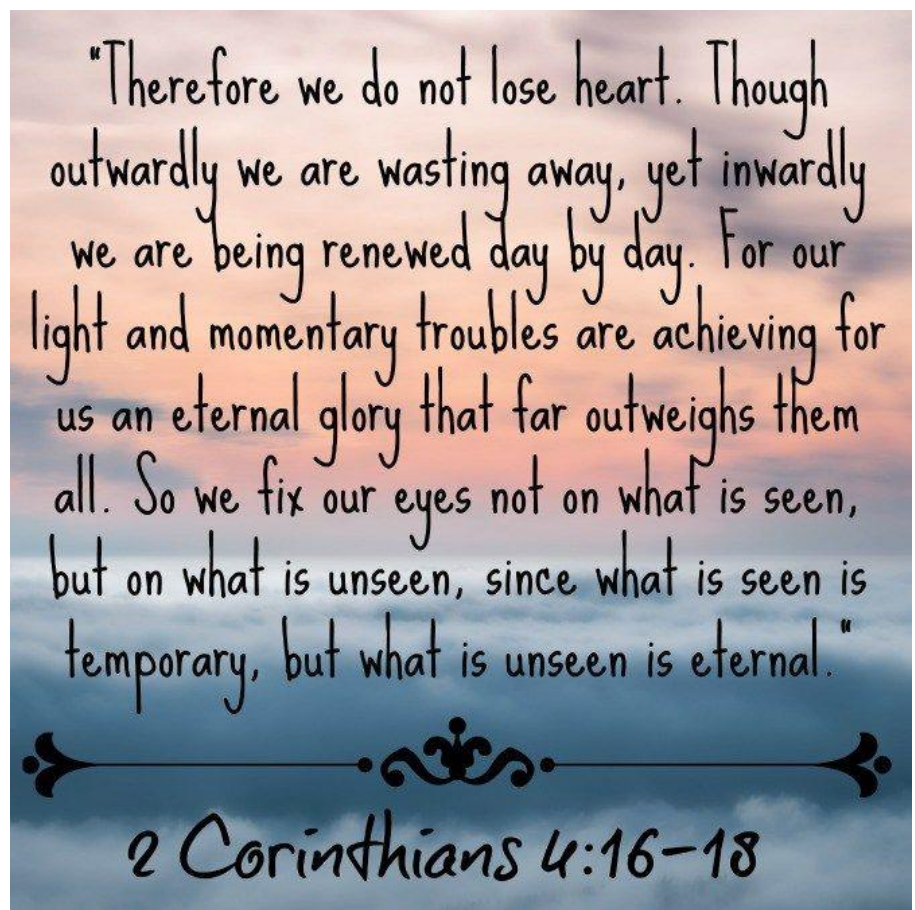

“Stand Still” or “Go Forward?”

When the Israelites left Egypt Pharaoh let them go at first but soon changed his mind and pursued them. The people were trapped between Pharaoh's chariots and the Red Sea. They complained that there were plenty of graves in Egypt if all God wanted to do was bring them out into the wilderness to be slaughtered. In Exodus 14:13 Moses told the people to "...Stand still, and see the salvation of the Lord..." Verse 15 records God's reply to Moses, "Why do you cry to Me? Tell the children of Israel to go forward."

Which should we do? Stand still or go forward? There is a difference. Moses' command to the people was to be quiet ("you shall hold your peace" verse 14) and wait for God to fight the battle for them. Instead, God fought the battle, but not while His people stood idly by. They were delivered after they stepped out in faith and crossed the Red Sea. Moses said, "Stand still." God replied, "Go forward."

God accomplishes great things with those who cooperate with Him. Read Hebrews 11. Abel sacrificed. Noah built. Abraham left his homeland. Sarah bore a son. Abraham and offered that son. Moses refused his position in Egypt. He kept the first Passover. Then, in verse 29, Hebrew 11 called passing through the Red Sea on dry land an act accomplished "by faith."

God saves by grace. We respond by faith. Our response of faith seems to always involve action. The ridiculous story of the flood victim who prayed for deliverance but drowned while God sent a firetruck, a boat and a helicopter is just that – ridiculous.

Baptism is not a work that earns anything. It is the response of a believing, repentant heart. God blesses His children with every spiritual blessing in Christ, but he expects us to get busy. The next time you read Ephesians 2:8 about salvation by grace, keep reading all the way to verse 10. He created us by grace, "for good works... that we should walk in them."
