**One Faith**

People believe all kinds of things. Remember when the “Flat Earth Society” was quoted during the moon landings claiming NASA was all a big hoax? Some believe the tangible (what one can perceive with one’s senses) is all that is real, while others believe that the tangible is only a figment of our collective imaginations. The phenomenon of individual beliefs is not new. The New Testament mentioned those who taught false doctrines (Romans 16:17; 2 John 9-10; Jude 4). Yet, Paul claimed that there is only one faith (Ephesians 4:5). How can this be true?

When the Bible discusses faith, it is usually referring to what one accepts as true, and in which one trusts (Hebrews 11:1-6). At least forty times in the New Testament the word is used differently. Rather than referring to what an individual happens to believe, it was used to mean the teachings that God expects all believers to accept. Acts 6:7 mentioned the fact that many priests were obedient to “the faith.” Acts 24:24 records that Felix and Drusilla heard Paul “concerning the faith in Christ.” In 1 Corinthians 16:13 Christians were taught to “stand fast in the faith.” Jude urged Christians to “earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered to the saints.”

That is what Paul meant when he wrote “There is... one faith” (Ephesians 4:4-5). While some then and now may try to create their own distinctive brand of doctrine, God has only one faith. The Bible is not a book that each has a right to interpret as he or she wishes, but each one is required to “rightly divide the word of truth” (2 Timothy 2:15). There may be thousands of faiths, but God approves only one. Unity in Christ demands that all faiths be abandoned for His.
