I Think I See Land

Two men were adrift in a lifeboat. Sunburned, hungry, thirsty, and despairing of rescue, one of the unfortunates went to God in prayer. "Lord," he prayed, "I know I've been a terrible sinner all my life. I've stolen, been a drunkard, a philanderer, and mean to almost everyone. If you'll get me out of this mess, I'll clean up my life. I'll stop drinking, cursing, and be kind to everyone I meet..." "Stop praying!" the other castaway said. "I think I see land!"

Repentance is not a last resort to manipulate God. Instead, it is prompted by being "cut to the heart" (Acts 2:37) by the word of God. It may involve fasting and prayer, but not as a last resort. It is more than sorrow. It is prompted by "godly sorrow" (2 Corinthians 7:10). If there is a "godly sorrow," there must be a worldly sorrow.

Perhaps the sorrow of two of Jesus' apostles best illustrates the difference. In Matthew 26:75 Peter "went out and wept bitterly" when he realized he had denied Christ. Judas also realized he had sinned by betraying Jesus. He tried to return the thirty pieces of silver. When the chief priests and elders refused to accept it, he threw the money in the temple and "went and hanged himself" (Matthew 27:5). Peter regretted his sin, and his godly sorrow led to repentance. Judas also regretted his sin, but, with the sorrow of the world, he despaired.

"Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord" (Acts 3:19)
