

Constituent Services

Many Americans don't realize that writing, debating, and voting on legislation may not be the most important work that members of Congress do. That is the visible work that goes on in Washington, D.C., but the invisible work is probably more important. Most members of Congress are eager to perform constituent services. When a voter asks his or her US Representative or Senator for help with a problem involving the federal government, the congressperson knows that future votes may depend upon the service provided. A representative may not be able to get enough members of the opposition party to vote on legislation his or her way, but a phone call to the right person in the vast federal bureaucracy will get results. He or she might even schedule an in-person meeting to get an important point across for you. Kay Granger (the representative for this district) visited my classroom, and told several stories about way she and other representatives helped individual constituents. She was justifiably proud of that service. I was very impressed with her concern for every individual in the district, and her willingness to help just one person.

Why write about that in the church bulletin? Perhaps someone needs to contact an elected official, but a better reason for writing is that God is better at "constituent services" than any elected official. God made the universe (John 1:3) and upholds it by the word (Hebrews 1:3), but cares about every sparrow who falls (Matthew 10:29). He is never too busy to listen to the prayer of a child (Matthew 18:10) or rejoice over the return of a prodigal (Luke 15:7,10,32).

Consider that Jesus instructed His disciples to pray for daily bread (Matthew 6:11). Rather than worrying, Paul instructed the Philippians that "in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God" (Philippians 4:6). God wants His children who "walk in the light" to "confess our sins" (1 John 1:7,9). He is omniscient, but still commands us to confess to Him. Jesus commands us to "ask," "seek" and "knock" (Matthew 7:7).

Have a problem with our government? Be sure to contact your Representative. For everything else – "take it to the Lord in prayer."
