Beautiful in Contact

A wealthy woman stored her most valuable jewelry in a safety deposit box. Her most prized piece was a string of pearls. She paid a sizeable fee for one of the bank's employees to wear that string of pearls to lunch once a week, guarded by two plainclothes guards. Why would she go to that expense? Because she believed pearls lose their luster unless they are in contact with the human body.

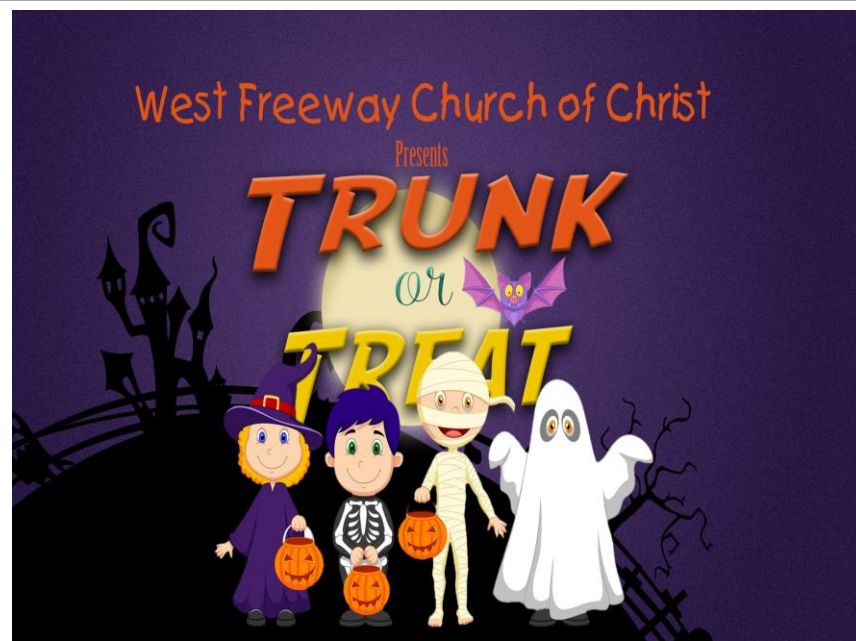
