### A Few Practical Ideas About Protecting the Assembly (Part III)

Since a church has the right and the obligation to protect the assembly physically as well as spiritually, allow me to suggest a few practical suggestions about improving security.

*Practice prevention.* Since the murderer who attacked our assembly did not survive, we cannot know just what motivated him. He had, however, been homeless at times. Like the West Freeway church, most churches interact frequently with individuals who need more than a single church can provide. Often, needy persons are dissatisfied with any help offered. When mental illness and/or intoxication complicate the problem, it may be impossible to avoid angering persons with evil intent. Romans 12:18 gives the benevolence worker the best advice, "If it be possible, as much as in you lieth, be at peace with all men." Like the difficult masters of 1 Peter 2:18, some individuals are so "froward" that they cannot be satisfied. Gentleness and compassion, even when the answer must be "no", are far safer than making a bad situation worse through understandably justifiable indignation.

*Practice good passive security.* Minimize entry points into the building, and supervise them. Security systems that magnetically secure doors against unauthorized entry are available. Does your building have effective video surveillance? HVAC systems may keep the brethren comfortable, but security systems help keep them safe. Individuals who pose an apparent threat ought to be contacted outside a locked door if possible.

*Be intentional.* Security is not an issue that can be postponed or ignored. By all means, pray for the Lord's protection, but prayer alone is not a security plan. Time is of the essence. We at West Freeway formed our security team within a year of the Southerland Springs killings, and hardly a year passed before we were put to the ultimate test. Start planning for security today.
