A Few Practical Ideas About Protecting the Assembly? (Final)

In addition to practicing prevention, good passive security, being intentional, initial and ongoing training and persistence, my final suggestions are...

Carry liability insurance. When a gun is fired, the shooter is responsible for what happens next. Security team members are accepting tremendous liability when they carry a concealed weapon in the assembly. If it is available, insurance coverage is wise. Being financially prepared for an unfortunate mistake, or even for a frivolous lawsuit is good stewardship.

Be prepared to invest. Security systems, video surveillance, and effective training are not free. On the other hand, neither are our pews, buildings, parking lots, staff members and a multitude of other priorities for which we willingly and wisely spend money. Security saves lives and money. Don't wait to make the investment until after tragedy has occurred. Don't let a good security ministry die of financial starvation, either.

One of the best decisions we made as elders in the West Freeway Church of Christ was to encourage Jack Wilson when he approached us about forming a security team. Many lives were saved. I feel safe in worship because of the swift, trained response of the whole security team. Prayerfully and carefully consider your responsibility to the spiritual and physical protection of the church the Holy Spirit has given you to oversee.

Allow me one final word. We are not just the church where the shooting took place. We have become more secure, and we have come to trust more fully on God. I feel more secure than ever as I worship here. I know that our security team, and our elders take your safety very seriously. I have been privileged to visit in churches of Christ in five states over the last few months. I have felt safest here. I know Satan is evil and his followers will resort even to physical violence to harm us. I thank God daily for this church.
